Any Sir Knight who has been the **first line signer** for a total of **three (3)** petitioners, who are either **knighted or restored** to membership since January 1, 2016, is eligible to receive the Member Citation Cord Award. There are various levels represented by different colors, to show your quantity of recruitment or restoration. Those being restored to membership must have been off the active roll for a period of one year or more to qualify in the count. The total is cumulative with no time boundaries. When <u>awarded</u> with a cord, it is to be worn on your left shoulder in your Class-A uniform.

A MESSAGE FROM THE EMINENT GRAND PRELATE

Love One Another

My Christian brothers and Sir Knights, we have much to praise God and be thankful for. John 13:34-35 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

February is the month of love. We celebrate Valentine's Day on Wednesday, February 14th. But for many Christians, that day is also Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. Which will end on Maundy Thursday, March 28th. Then follows Good Friday and Holy Saturday, March 29th and 30th. So, from February 14th to March 30th, not including Sundays, is 40 days.

Forty is typically indicative of a time of testing, trial, penance, purification, and renewal. In the New Testament, forty days is the length of Jesus' time of trial in the desert in preparation for his public ministry, proclaiming the Gospel.

I pray, Sir Knights, that each of you take this time to not just reflect on the past but look forward to the future and prepare your heart, mind, and soul to walk in the truth of our Lord Jesus Christ and to love one another. He touched my life, and he will be missed.
