ADDENDUM to GENERAL ORDER NO. 7, SERIES 2020-2021

Subject: Reopening Schedule for Constituent Commanderies of the Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Texas

To: The Grand Officers, Past Grand Commanders, Officers and Members of the Constituent Commanderies of Texas.

Greetings, Sir Knights:

In accordance with the provisions delineated in **Texas General Order #7**, "Reopening the Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Texas," following is the Phased Reopening Schedule for Texas Commanderies. This schedule is based on Texas Executive Order GA-32 COVID Hospitalization Data. Commanderies in TSAs with the preceding 14 days below 15% capacity and trending downward *will be considered* for increasing phases. Commanderies above 15% at any time in the last 14 days and trending upward will be fully restricted to Phase 0. Placement is at the discretion of the Grand Commander

This schedule will be re-evaluated and potentially revised semi-monthly. Depending on the current state of the pandemic in the various hospital regions across Texas, as well as other Federal, State, Local, and masonic factors, **Commanderies may be moved up or down** on the schedule, relative to risk. **This schedule supersedes those prior to 4/1/2021**, and will remain in effect until superseded.

Sir Knights, whether or not you are allowed to meet in-person, please be considerate of your brethren and your fellow man, and consider the risk to others in all that you do. While there may be a light at the end of the tunnel, we are not out of the woods yet.

REMINDER: MASKS ARE REQUIRED at all in-person meetings until further notice.
